PROJECT GELDING

Criteria for Stallions Accepted for Project Gelding

- All stallions must be fairly clean and in good health at the time of the veterinary appointment. Proof of negative Coggins test, current vaccinations and deworming are required. Minimum vaccinations are Tetanus Toxoid and West Nile; recommended are East/West Encephalitis and Rhino flu. If other requirements are necessary you will be contacted.
- Stallions must have 2 descended testicles and be between 4 months and 5 years of age.
- Participating stallions must be halter broke and arrive at the veterinary clinic in a well fitted halter with a sturdy lead rope. They must arrive with a qualified handler. If the participant brings multiple stallions to a clinic each horse must have its own handler.
